ALCALA TRIO TO OPEN USD MUSIC SEASON

SAN DIEGO, CALIF.--The University of San Diego winter music season will open with the Oct. 17 performance of the Alcala Trio in an all Mendelssohn program.

Members of the trio are Henry Kolar, violinist; Marjorie Hart, cellist, and Ilana Mysior, pianist. The three are members of the USD music faculty.

Mendelssohn works to be performed will be Violin Sonata in F Minor, Op. 4; Cello Sonata in D Major, Op. 58; Rondo Capriccioso in E Minor for Piano Solo; and Trio in D Minor, Op. 49.

The concert will be given at 8 p.m. in the Camino Hall Theatre.

The USD Opera Workshop will present Johann Strauss' "Die Fledermause," Nov. 20-21. Also taking part in the performance will be the USD Chorus.

Vivaldi's "Gloria" for choir and strings will be featured at the Dec. 13 program. Ilana Mysior and B. Jeffrey Brown will perform Mozart's Two Piano Concerto in E Flat, K. 365, accompanied by the orchestra.

Jonathan Miller, cellist, will appear Dec. 20. A member of Pablo Casals' master class, Miller is also principal cellist with the Hartford (Conn.) Symphony.

Dramatic soprano Justeen Widoff will have completed a concert tour of Eastern Europe before appearing at USD Feb. 8. Miss Widoff, of Los Angeles, has been an artist in the community concert series.

Harold Zabrack, pianist, composer and lecturer, will appear in concert Feb. 15. Zabrack has performed as soloist presenting his own works with the Chicago and St. Louis Symphonies.

The season will end with a performance on Feb. 22 by the Alcala Trio. The works to be presented will be announced at a later date.
