BANK TRUST COUNSEL NAMED TO USD BOARD OF TRUSTEES

SAN DIEGO, Calif.--The appointment of Bruce V. Wagner, trust counsel for Southern California First National Bank, to the University of San Diego Board of Trustees, was announced this week by the Rev. Msgr. John E. Baer, president of the university.

Wagner, an alumnus of USD, was honored as a St. Thomas More Scholar when he received his law degree from the School of Law in 1963. The honor is the highest academic distinction granted by the school.

At that time he also received the Phi Alpha Delta Outstanding Senior Award and the Phi Delta Phi Outstanding Graduate award. He received his bachelor's degree from Marquette University in 1953.

Wagner has been with Southern California First National Bank for six years. Prior to that he was with the City Attorney's Office and in private practice.

He co-authored, with Judge James M. Carter of the 9th U.S. Circuit Court, the lead article in the first edition of USD's San Diego Law Review, and he has continued to contribute on trust and probate law matters.

He has been on faculty at the USD School of Law teaching trusts.

He is immediate past chairman of the probate section of the San Diego Bar Association. He is also a member of the tax and business law sections of the bar. Active in the legislative committee, he has represented the bar

Wagner is the first graduate of the School of Law to serve on the USD board of Trustees, said Acting Dean Joseph S. Brock.
