The University of San Diego will be the setting for the hit comedy "Don't Drink the Water" by Woody Allen on March 28, 29, and 30. Produced by the Alcala Park Players, the play in two acts will be performed in Camino Theatre, curtain time at 8 p.m.

Set in the American Embassy behind the Iron Curtain, the play spoofs the mishaps of three vacationing American tourists from New Jersey who are suspected of being spies by the head of the Communist Secret Police.

While seeking assylum and later formulating a plan for escape, the Walter Hollander family endures a refugee priest whose hobby is magic, a tempermental Italian cook, an ambitious young Embassy assistant, and an inebriated, but oil rich Sultan from Bashir. All this takes place by way of the hilarious bungling of the Ambassador's son, left in charge during his absence.

Mr. B.R. Van Vleck, Associate Professor of Speech at USD, will direct the March production. Van Vleck has directed dramatic productions and speech arts at USD since 1955.
