"American Primitive Sculpture" opens at the University of San Diego's Founders Gallery October 3, and will be on display until November 6.

The show consists of wooden contemporary folk carvings, primarily from the Appalachian area, accompanied by Joseph Munson's photographic documentation on Appalachian Folk Sculptors and Their Environment.

Part of the collection was exhibited this spring at Rockefeller Plaza, New York City, and the entire collection was part of the inaugural exhibition for the new Museum of Craft and Folk Art in Los Angeles this summer.

Founders Gallery is open 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. weekdays and is open to the public free of charge.
