RALPH NADER AT USD

The country's most noted consumer crusader, Ralph Nader, will bring his theories of corporate power and public advocacy to San Diego when he speaks to students at the University of San Diego's Camino Theater on Wednesday, Sept. 27, at 8 p.m.

Nader first made headlines in 1965 with his book "Unsafe at Any Speed," a scathing indictment of the nation's auto industry for producing unsafe vehicles. He and his organization have been responsible for at least six major federal consumer protection laws, the recall of millions of defective motor vehicles, and for countless regulations in the areas of safety, sanitation, pollution control, and advertising credibility.

Nader's speech at USD is sponsored by the Associated Students Speakers Bureau. Speakers Bureau Jeff More says admission to the Nader speech is free to USD students, \$1.50 to USD law students and graduate students, \$2.50 to other students, and \$3.50 to the general public.
