AFFIRMATIVE ACTION TOPIC OF USD UPDATE SEMINAR, MARCH 14

"Making Affirmative Action Work" will be examined during the first University of San Diego UPDATE Breakfast Seminar on Friday, March 14, 7:30 a.m., in the Banquet Room of the Hanalei Hotel.

The series of eight UPDATE meetings runs through May 2, and is designed to give San Diego business people an opportunity to interact with University of San Diego School of Business faculty.

Dr. Fred Bahr, Associate Professor of Management at USD, will lead the seminar. Bahr will examine the efforts of business to insure the efficiency and effectiveness of affirmative action programs.
