"AIDS: MYTH VERSUS REALITY IS"
TOPIC OF NURSING SCHOOL NOV. 6 TALK

The latest information on the AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome) epidemic will be presented at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 6, at the University of San Diego School of Nursing.

Phyllis Spechko, a UC San Diego research nurse practitioner, will deliver a speech she has entitled, "AIDS: Myth Versus Reality," in Room 106 of the nursing school.

Assigned to UCSD Medical Center's Division of Infectious Diseases, she is one of a handful of nurses working on AIDS research in California.

Much of her talk will be based on a three-year Medical Center study in which some 300 homosexuals took part.

The two-hour discussion is free and open to the public.
