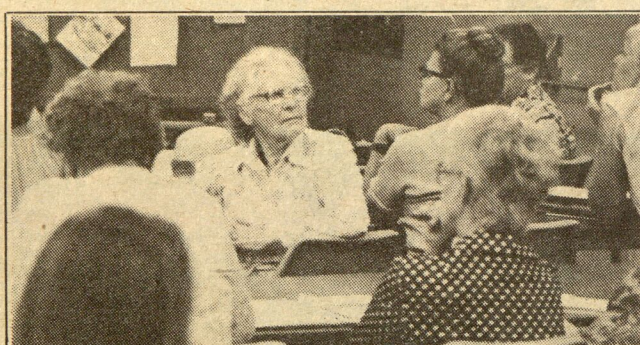

## The Impossible Dream Becomes Reality

The USD School of Graduate and Continuing Studies, under the guidance of Mal Rafferty and General Victor H. Krulak made a dream become a reality for many persons. This was accomplished through a unique program called the "University of the Third Age."

Through the program here at the University, I rediscovered the secret of good health through controlled exercise, and the stimulation of the mind. The mental stimuli of the lectures and classes, plus the daily exercise class began to change my life. While the U3A experience provided a signpost for handling retirement, it also presented me with some major decisions. I chose to continue the exercise program under Rene Regalot, of the Park and Recreation department. Then I asked for an opportunity to volunteer my services as a tutor here at the University. I was now an alumnus, following the joining of the University of the Third Age Alumni group. Dr. Ray Brandes, Graduate Dean, responded to my request for becoming a tutor, and for two years I did academic tutoring in languages, music, and english. Sister Sarre, of the Spanish department, welcomed me, and referred several students to me for help.

Last spring, Dr. Brandes asked me to be the coordinator for the Economic Opportunity Program, known as EOP here on our campus. I knew it would be rewarding, as I had been responsible for the EOP program in the high school from which I had retired.

The objective of the EOP program is to provide special assistance to students of all races, creeds and colors who do not meet the required admissions standard. Once admitted, a student is under obligation to accept the tutorial program. This means being tutored regularly in all academic subjects. This same service is also available to other students who find themselves in need of academic help.

Some thirty-two students are enrolled in the EOP program. Eight tutors from the University provide regular academic counseling. An additional ten to fifteen non EOP students are also receiving help from our tutors.

Of the forty-five students many are Hispanic Americans and Black students as well as Caucasian. There are Native Americans and Asian students also.

The EOP office is located in Founder's Hall, Room 158A, and is under my direction.

Thus one dream is now a reality, and I am employed here at the beautiful University of San Diego.

## U3A Winter Session January 5-23

"It was one of the most positive experiences of my life," recalls Stella Smiler, speaking of USD's University of the Third Age (U3A). Mrs. Smiler, 69, an alumna of the 1978 U3A, remembers "the warmth and kindness of the people involved" and credits the program for lasting changes in her life.

In its fourth year at USD, the innovative educational program is based on a French model, designed for the revitalization of senior citizens by means of mental challenge and physical exercise.

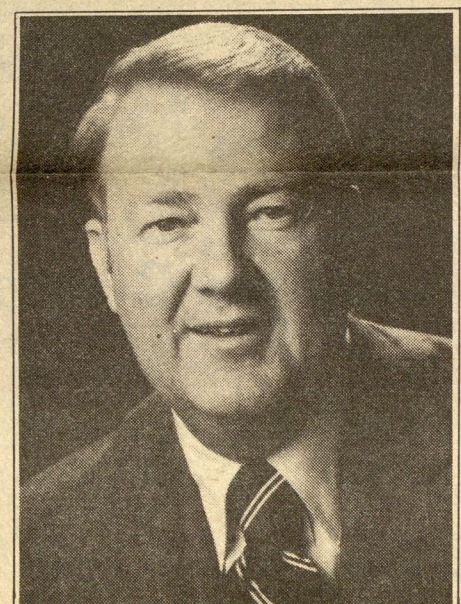

## Ed Meese, Reagan's Aide On Leave From USD



Meese always introduced himself to each new employee in Governor Reagan's office and took a few moments to get to know them. "I had perhaps 25 to 30 people under me and Ed knew every one of their names. Sometimes I couldn't remember their names, but Ed always did."

The purpose of the Center over which Professor Meese presides is to contribute to the improvement of the criminal justice system. It concentrates on four functional areas: Legal Education, Research and Publications, Conferences, and Public Service/Special Projects. One of the Center's particular concerns is the range of problems encountered by crime victims and witnesses.

In addition to his USD post and his private practice, Professor Meese is vice-chairman of the state Organized Crime Control Commission. He also serves on the state Peace Officers Standards and Training Advisory Committee.

# Benefactors Honor Roll

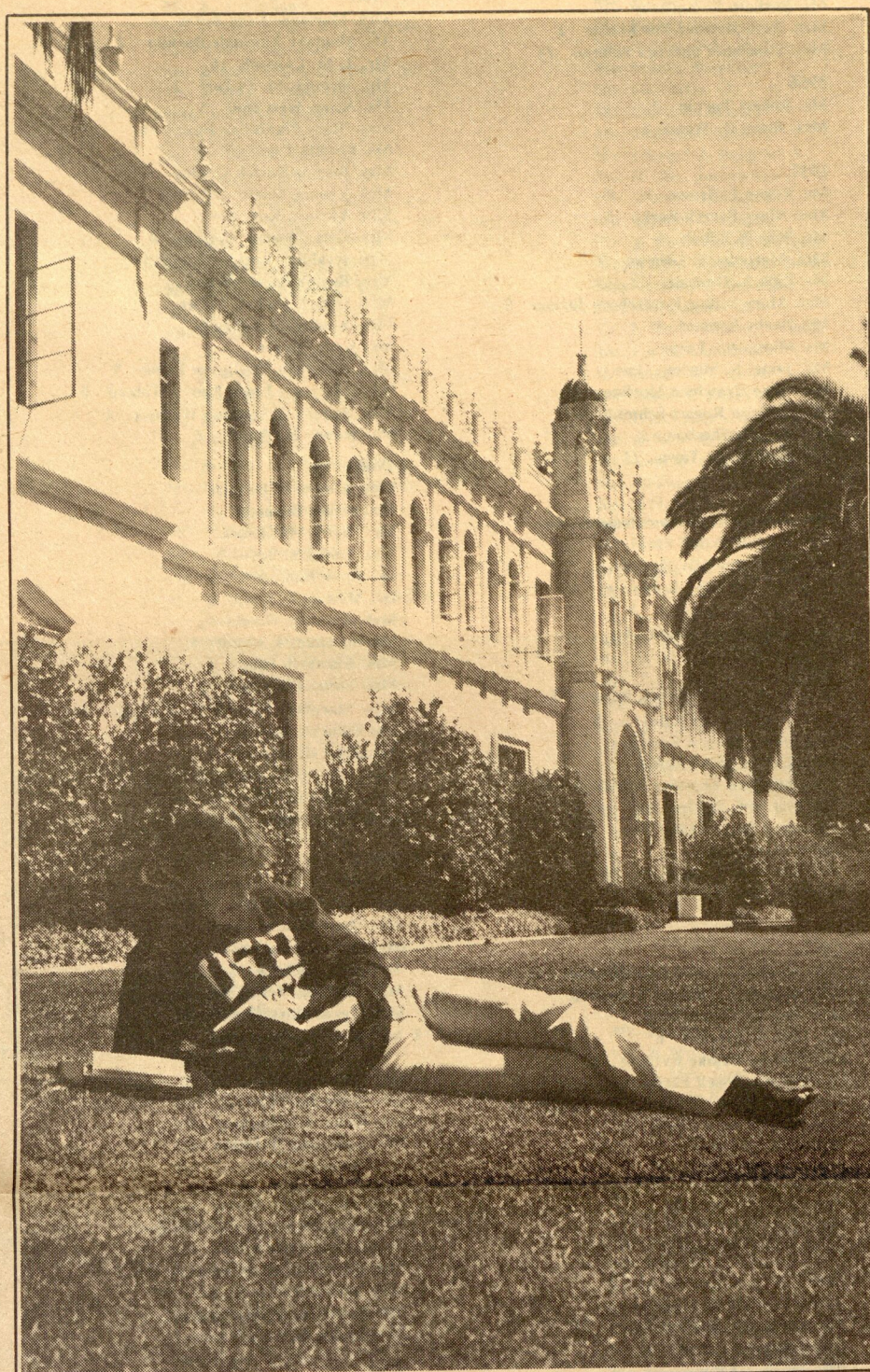

## Law Dean Search Committee Narrows Field

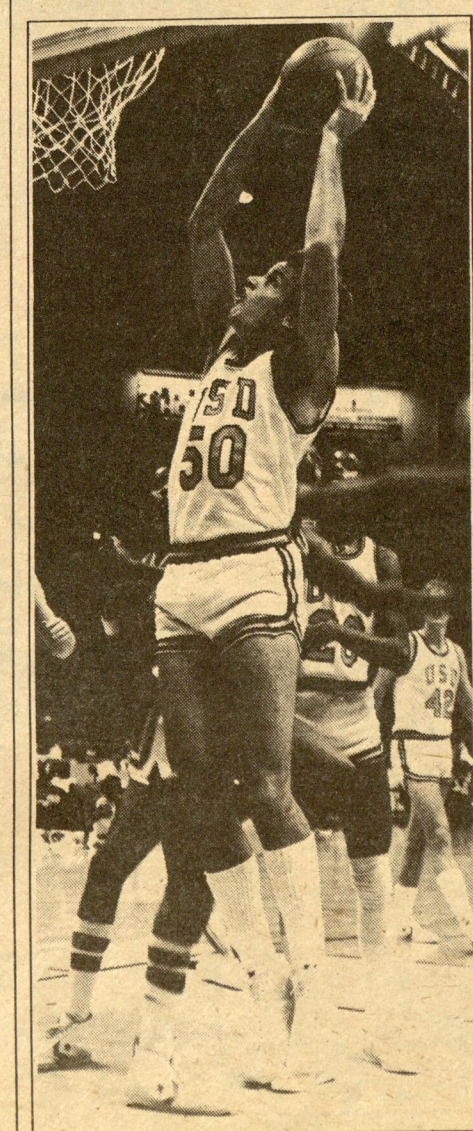
## World Series Dream Realized

## Former Torero All American Plays For Royals

USD Alumnus John Wathan (1971) realized a life-long goal this past October when he played World Series ball for the Kansas City Royals.

John's love of baseball began here in San Diego where he played Little League and umpired for Mission Bay Youth Leagues. Upon graduating from St. Augustine High School, Wathan was awarded a baseball scholarship at USD. During his three years at USD, John had a career batting average of .347 and led the team in runs batted in and stolen bases. In 1970, he earned "All-American" honors after hitting an

impressive .430 for the Toreros. While in his senior year at USD, John was drafted by the Kansas City Royals and subsequently signed with them for a substantial bonus. During his best year in the minors, John batted over .300 and was named the All-State Catcher of the year. Impressed with John's record, the Kansas City Royals gave him the opportunity to prove himself in the "Big League." John has been with the Royals ever since and is regarded as one of the finest utility players in baseball, being proficient in the outfield, at first base, or behind the plate. John placed among the top 10 hitters in the American League during the regular 1980 season. His final statistics included a .305 batting average, 6 home runs, 58 RBI's, and 17 stolen bases in 20 attempts.



That John Wathan realized his dream and participated in World Series ball is no surprise to those who know him best. John exemplifies those attributes that are the cornerstones of the USD Athletic Department's program — leadership, sportsmanship, courage, stamina, camaraderie, and self-esteem. Among his most supportive fans are his wife, Nancy, and his sons Dusty and Derek.

## Torero Basketball

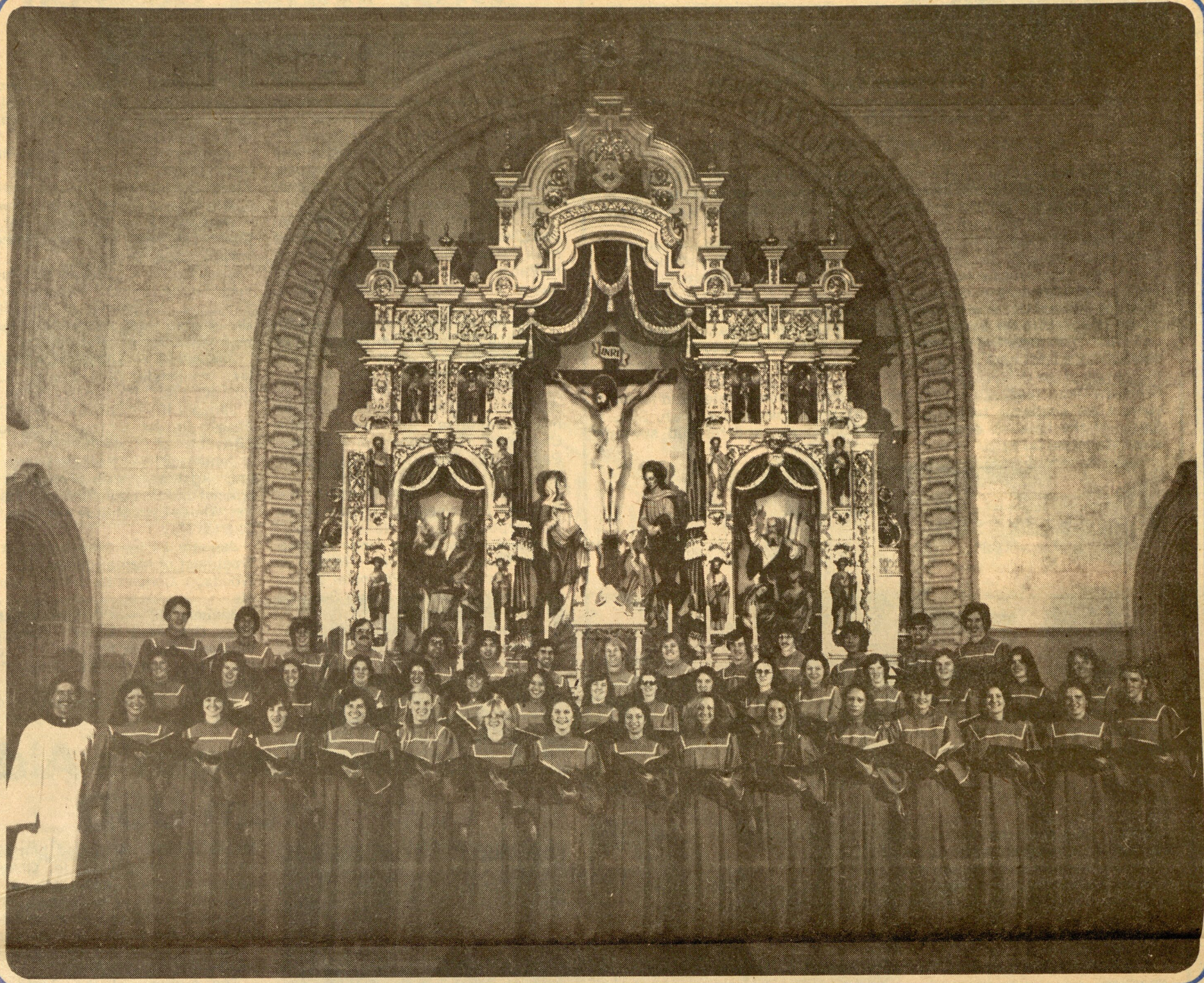
