PARTNERSHIPS FUELING THE REGION

Our region is stronger when we work together. Here's how our members are preparing San Diego for the future.

SDG&E and **CalFire** are working closely to monitor and fight wildfires.

The Climate Collaborative found a new home at USD's Nonprofit Institute.

The Port of San Diego and the Navy Region
Southwest, the two largest land managers around San
Diego Bay, signed a Memorandum of Agreement to
coordinate on sea level rise planning. This represents the
first-of-its kind agreement between the U.S. Navy and a
West Coast port.

The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority's new Parking Plaza has involved 150 small businesses and will include innovative water recycling systems.

The City of San Diego is working with community groups like San Diego County Bike Coalition and Circulate San Diego to encourage alternative transportation.
