UNITED STATES FOREIGN SERVICE BENEFITS FROM USD PROFESSOR'S PAPER

SAN DIEGO, Calif. --The State Department in Washington has placed a special report by Dr. A. Paul Theil, University of San Diego, in their Foreign Affairs Documentation Center.

The report on the de-emphasis of English in Ceylon was first presented as a lecture by Dr. Theil at the international meeting for Asian Studies in Philadelphia in March. Theil, who is chairman of the Political Science department at USD, was the only American to present a paper.

By placing the report in the documentation center, the State Department makes it available as part of the collection of significant studies in foreign affairs available to all US missions abroad, in addition to governmental agencies in the United States.

Theil was special advisor to the United States delegation which co-ordinated the work for the south-east Asia Colombo plan.
