USD HISTORY PROFESSOR TO SPEAK AT UCSD

SAN DIEGO, Calif. --Dr. Ray Brandes, associate professor of history at the University of San Diego, will lecture Oct. 10 at the University of California at San Diego.

Dr. Brandes is one of ten Southern California historians and anthropologists lecturing at UCSD as a part of a three-unit course on "A Cultural History of the Greater San Diego Area." He will speak on "The Spanish Period: The Missions and the Ranchos."

"The course presents a survey of the cultures and peoples who have lived in the greater San Diego area from aboriginal times to the present, " said Dr. Brandes. "I will present the history of the San Diego area missions and ranchos from a cultural approach, through the people's use of tools, and their social stratification."

Dr. Brandes will also describe archaeological research he has carried out at Mission San Diego de Alcala.
