## UNIVERSITY OF SAN DIEGO LEADERS TO ATTEND EDUCATION CONFERENCE

SAN DIEGO, Calif. --University of San Diego administrators left yesterday (Wednesday) to meet in Denver with educators and leaders of most major colleges and universities in the United States. They are attending a conference on "The Future Academic Community: Continuity and Change."

Attending from USD are Sister Nancy Morris, President of the College for Women; Sister Nancy Furay, Academic Dean of the College for Women; the Very Rev. John E. Baer, President, College for Men and Dr. Henry J. Martin, Academic Dean, College for Men.

The three-day meeting is the 51st annual convention of the American Council on Education.

"Ways will be considered of resolving tensions created by the need to change to meet new needs and conditions," according to the conference agenda. "At the same time it is necessary to ensure the preservation of the valuable continuities essential to the preservation of knowledge."
