DIVISION OF NATURAL SCIENCES AND MATHEMATICS

Dr. McDermott, chairman of the Division of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, has been invited by the Bureau of Secondary Education to participate in the evaluation of a new program of science instruction for the public schools. The new program, which is now being prepared for field testing, has evolved from activities of the State Advisory Committee on Science Education. In this project, Dr. McDermott will be associated with Dr. Ralph Gerard, dean of the Graduate Division, UC (Irvine), and Mr. S. Giuliani, San Diego City Unified School District.

FACULTY ASSOCIATION

Second Session Previous Meeting will meet on Tuesday, February 21, at 12:15 in Rm. 207.

At the First Session the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

That the Faculty Association advise the Administration of its desire to establish the policy, among other criteria to be determined, of giving increased weight over the actual possession of the terminal degree to the reputation of a professor as a good teacher, to his services rendered to the college, and to his continued professional advancement.

After hearing the interesting report of Mr. John Cunningham, chairman of the Student Affairs Committee, of student questions about charges of plagiarism, lowering of grades after semester work was completed, re-evaluation of honors requirements, uniformity in departments with a view of standardized tests, and the requirement of a thesis for seniors, the Association approved a motion to instruct the Student Affairs Committee to send a memo to the appropriate faculty committees concerned with these questions and to report back the action of the committees to the Faculty Association.
