USD PROFESSOR ON THE EFFECT OF MOVIES ON HISTORY

SAN DIEGO, Calif. --The effect of the movie industry on historical writing will be the subject of a presentation to the annual Western Historical Association meeting Thursday by Dr. Ray Brandes, associate professor of history at the University of San Diego.

The meeting is to be held Oct. 17-18 in Tucson, Ariz. Another delegate from USD is author and California historian Dr. Iris Wilson, associate professor of history.

Dr. Brandes will have 20 of his own history students among his listeners when his paper on "The Impact of the Western Motion Picture on the Writing of History" is presented. The students are attending the conference as observers.
