Historical Note

Prior to becoming a unified University of San Diego, USD was home to two independent schools, the San Diego College for Women and the University of San Diego College for Men. The College for Men was also home to the School of Law. Beginning in 1967, serious discussions began about merging the two colleges. Throughout 1968 joint curricula began to develop, academic calendars and class times were aligned, and departments began to merge. In January 1970, the Boards of Trustees agreed to begin the search for a President of the Coordinate Colleges. Chaired by Philosophy Professor Father William Shipley, the Presidential Search

Committee included trustees, administrators, faculty, and students. In May 1971, Author Hughes was selected to be the first President of the University of San Diego.
