LOYOLA THEATER GROUP EXCHANGE PROGRAM WITH USD

SAN DIEGO, Calif. --The Del Rey Players of Loyola University, Los Angeles, will present two performances of "Advise and Consent" at the University of San Diego Nov. 8 and 9 at 8: 00 p.m. The performance, which is part of an interchange program between the two universities, is the play by Loring Mandel based on the well known novel of Washington intrigue.

The Del Rey Players, a nationally recognized group directed by Paul Kaufman of Loyola faculty consists of approximately 125 students. They present five productions each year in Los Angeles and San Francisco. This is the first year of exchange with San Diego.

Arrangements for interchange performances were recently completed by Del Rey president, Ken Peters, and Kathleen Zaworski, USD theater arts department head.

The exchange visits will continue when the USD theater arts department stage "Member of the Wedding" by Carlson McCullers on the Loyola campus in April, as part of Del Rey Players Theater Spectrum 1968-69.

Tickets for "Advise and Consent", which will be staged at the USD College for Women theater, may be purchased at all schools on the campus. General admission is \$2, students \$1.50. (Special discount tickets for USD students are \$1 if purchased before opening night).
