SCIENTOLOGIST TO SPEAK AT USD

SAN DIEGO, Calif. --A Scientologist's view of the condition of mankind will be presented at noon, Wed., Nov. 13, at the University of San Diego. David Russell of the La Jolla Institute of Scientology will speak in More Hall on "Where are we? Where are we going?"

The Church of Scientology was founded in 1952 as an "applied religious philosophy," combining portions of Eastern and Western philosophy and religious thought. Scientology has grown to 22 headquarters in six countries, and ten churches in the United States. The British government in August rejected the attempt of Scientologists to enter Britian in order to hold an international congress.
