ALUMNUS JUDGE TO SPEAK AT U.S.D.

SAN DIEGO, Calif. -- Judge Richard Donovan of the San Diego Municipal Court will discuss the functions of the municipal court system Wednesday, Nov. 20, at the University of San Diego.

Judge Donovan, president of the USD School of Law Alumni Association, will speak in More Hall. He is the first graduate of the USD School of Law to hold a judgeship.

The talk is the third in a series sponsored by the students Law Forum, said Paul Fisher, director.

A. L. Wirin, chief counsel of the American Civil Liberties Union of Southern California, and San Diego City Attorney Edward Butler will appear on the Forum's next program, Dec. 4. The two will discuss society's conflicting desire for increased law and order and the desire for the protection of rights under the First Amendment, Fisher said.
