EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

An article entitled "Choosing a College: Differences in Perception Between Seniors and School Counselors," and written by Dr. Jack R. Morrison, Acting Chairman of the College for Men Department of Education, appears in the Nov. issue of "The School Counselor," the journal for the American School Counselor Association, a division of the American Personnel and Guidance Association. A major purpose of the study was to determine how accurately school counselors understand the thinking of college-bound seniors in choosing their college. Factors influencing the decision making of liberal arts college bound high school seniors are discussed.

A companion article, "Factors Influential in College Selection" appeared in the Jan. 1968 issue of "The Clearing House," a journal for modern junior and senior high schools.

PHYSICS DEPARTMENT

Dr. Estberg has been awarded a grant of \$2000 by the National Science Foundation in support of research during the 68-69 and 69-70 academic years. The research in atomic theory was begun in the summer of 1968 at Louisiana State University in collaboration with Dr. R. Labahn under the Research Participation Program for College Teachers sponsored by The National Science Foundation. The results of the work done last summer will be published in "Physics Letters." Dr. Estberg will return to Louisiana next summer to continue this research.
