CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

Actions taken by the Curriculum Committee at meeting held Thursday, Feb. 15: (continued on page 2)

The Committee passed unanimously Dr. Estberg's proposed curriculum for pre-engineering with the title amended to "Inter-departmental Physical Science Program."

Agenda for meeting scheduled for 12:00 noon, Thursday, Feb. 22 in Room 208: Proposed changes in the English curriculum.

ACADEMIC STANDARDS AND HONORS COMMITTEE

At a meeting Jan. 12, the Committee recommended that the standards for Honors at Graduation be maintained at their present level. At a meeting Feb. 16, the following policy statement was unanimously recommended: "It is understood that the greater part of a student's work in the first two years of college will be preparatory and prerequisite to the mature work of upper division courses. Where the necessary prerequisite training has resulted in a basic proficiency, subject to the approval of the Departmental Chairman, a freshman or sophomore may enroll at any time in an upper division course and receive upper division credit." It was also recommended that "A Minor be not required; that provision for it be continued for those individuals or departments that desire it; and that such a Minor will consist of 5 courses of which at least 2 will be upper division courses."

PHILOSOPHY DEPARTMENT

The Department of Philosophy has submitted to the Academic Dean for distribution to all members of the faculty the following information concerning proposed departmental changes:

- 1) Delete Phil. 151: Augustine from the courses of instruction in the College Bulletin (p. 103 of the 1967-1968 Bulletin).
- Delete Language 3 from the Philosophy program of study (p. 45 of 1967-1968 Bulletin), first semester, Sophomore year. This was a departmental requirement, which is being dropped.

According to the procedure recommended by the Curriculum Committee and approved by the President, any faculty member who sees some problem in this proposal should communicate this in writing to the Academic Dean within five instructional days, i.e., Feb. 29.
