Law School Dean:

I am pleased to announce the appointment of Professor Sheldon Krantz as Dean of USD's School of Law, effective in July, 1981. Currently Professor of Law at Boston University, Sheldon Krantz has previously been Director of the Boston University Center for Criminal Justice, Executive Director of the Massachusetts Governor's Committee on Law Enforcement and Administration of Justice, a trial attorney for the U. S. Department of Justice, and a staff attorney for the President's Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Justice. Professor Krantz is a graduate of the University of Nebraska School of Law, where he was Editor-in-Chief of the Nebraska Law Review and a member of the Order of the Coif.

We are happy that Dean Donald Weckstein of the School of Law will remain at USD as a full-time faculty member.

Interession Enrollment:

January, 1981 Interession enrollment consisted of 543 students enrolled for 1606 units. We were budgeted for 400 students taking 1200 units. Hence, we are above budget for the Interession period. Interession of 1980 had 444 students, while Interession, 1979 had 373 students.

Spring Pre-Registration:

In early December, 1980, the following number of students pre-enrolled for spring semester. For comparative purposes, figures for the last two years are included:
