USD STUDENT TO LECTURE BEFORE SCIENCE CLUB

SAN DIEGO, Calif.--A University of San Diego senior will discuss radiation research at the USD Science Club meeting Thursday, March 13. The club will meet at 11 a.m. in the USD College for Women audio-visual room.

Eleanor Blakely will report on her studies as a trainee last summer at Oak Ridge Nuclear Facility. Her talk will be on wet desquamation in fractionate irradiation.

Miss Blakely is the daughter of Col. and Mrs. James Blakely, Marine Corps Recruit Depot, San Diego. She, the only San Diegan to receive a grant to participate in the program, was one of five from California.

A biology major at the University of San Diego, Miss Blakely is a research assistant for Sister Bernice Farrens, chairman of the USD College for Women biology department.

Miss Blakely's work at Oak Ridge Cancer Research Hospital included the response of the skin of mice to periodic doses of radiation. She served as assistant to Dr. Frank Comas, chief radio therapist.
