JESUIT THEOLOGIAN TO LECTURE AT USD

SAN DIEGO, Calif.----"The Primitive Faith and the Contemporary Christian" will be the subject of a lecture Saturday, July 5, at the University of San Diego.

The Reverend David M. Stanley, S. J., professor of theology at Regis College, Onatrio, Canada, lecturer and author, will contrast the condition of modern day faith with that held by the early Christians. The lecture will be held in the USD College for Women Theatre at 8 p.m. There is no charge.

The Jesuit theologian taught at the University of Iowa's School of Religion and was a participant in the Catholic-Protestant Colloquium in 1963 at Harvard University.
