POLITICAL SPEAKERS AT USD

SAN DIEGO, Calif.----A congressman, the state superintendent of public instruction and three state legislators heard the speaker's program sponsored by the Political Science Club of the University of San Diego, Alcala Park.

The club will also sponsor films and student panels and debates on controversial national and local issues during the fall semester, said senior Jack Kaufman, club president.

Deddeh, D-Chula Vista, 12:15 p.m. Monday, October 27; State Assemblyman Pete Wilson, R-San Diego, 12:15 p.m. Friday, November 7; State Senator James R. Miles, D-San Diego, 12:15 p.m. Friday, November 14; Superintendent of Public Instruction Max Rafferty, 12:15 p.m. Thursday, November 20.

All meetings will be held in the Rose Room of the USD College for Women.
