#### FACT OF FAITH BEGINS THIRD PROGRAM

SAN DIEGO, Calif.-----Fact of Faith, an adult religious education series, will begin the third presentation of its program Oct. 7. The course will be given at the Oak Crest High School, Encinitas.

Previous sessions of the religious education series have been given on the University of San Diego campus. The classes will meet Tuesdays at 8 p.m. The series ends Nov. 25.

The series of lectures on matters of scriptures, morals, liturgy and church structure is being sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul Council 5012, Encinitas. The course is approved for credit for Confraternity of Christian Doctrine teachers, said Dr. John Swanke, chairman of the adult education program.

The Very Rev. John Portman will speak on the structure of the church; Rev. Laurence P. Dolan, scripture; the Very Rev. Michael Alcaraz, liturgy, and Swanke, morals.

Swanke is a professor of philosophy at the University of San Diego. Father Portman is chairman of the Department of Religious Studies, and chairman of the Diocesan Ecumenical Commission. Father Alcaraz is a professor of religious studies and executive secretary of the Diocesan Liturgical Commission. Father Dolan is also a professor of religious studies.

The series will cost \$10, or \$15 per couple, or \$2 per lecture. For
