USD PROFESSOR PANELIST AT LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS CONFERENCE

SAN DIEGO, CALIF.--Dr. John Bradshaw, University of San Diego professor of Biology, will be a panelist at the California Council of Landscape Architects Conference in San Diego October 2 to 4.

Bradshaw will speak on the Environmental Problems of Coastal Lagoons. The panel's theme is "New Trends in Development of Flood Plains, Oceans and Riverfront Lands." The conference will be held at the Bahia Motor Hotel.

Other members of the panel at the second session, 9 to 11:45 a.m. Oct. 3, will be Phillip Lammi, Environmental Division, Corps of Engineers, San Francisco; Robert D. Montgomery, Department of Fish and Game; and John Sue, landscape architect, Oakland.

The conference is divided into three major sections. The first is student participation. The second is action projects, new trends and accomplishments in the improvement of man's environment.

The third section is concerned with the use of off-the-road vehicles and their impact upon the space in which they are used.
