TEACHING OF CHILDREN WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES TOPIC OF USD TALK

SAN DIEGO, Calif.--Dr. Alex Bannatyne, a nationally noted authority in the field of special education will speak at the University of San Diego Wednesday, March 3. He is the second speaker in the Special Education Lecture Series sponsored by the Special Education Division of the department of education.

The lecture will be at 8 p.m. in De Sales Hall Auditorium, and it is open to the public without charge.

Dr. Bannatynes's topic is "Teaching Children with Learning Disabilities: Models for the 70's." He is director of the Bannatyne Children's Learning Center, Miami, Florida. Author of numerous articles and programs for children with learning disabilities, he was formerly research professor at the Institute for Research on Exceptional Children, University of Illinois.
