DR. HENRY KOLAR TO CONDUCT USD ORCHESTRA IN CONCERT

SAN DIEGO, Calif.--Thirty string players, woodwinds and brass will perform Mozart's Prague Symphony No. 38 as a major work in the USD Orchestra Concert, on Friday, November 19. The public is invited to attend.

Curtain time is 8:15 p.m. in the Camino Theatre at the University of San Diego. Miss Regina Birkner, flutist from USIU, will play the solo in the Night Soliloquoy by Kent Kenan. Other compositions on this exciting program are the Polish Concerto by Telemann, Serenade for Strings by Suk, and Arensky's Variations on a Theme of Tchaikovsky for String Orchestra.

Musicians who are USD students, faculty members and persons from the San Diego community comprise the University of San Diego Orchestra. Dr. Henry Kolar, conductor, has served as concertmaster of the San Diego Symphony Orchestra, the San Diego Youth Symphony and has been guest conductor for various festivals. Presently chairman of the outstanding music department of the University of San Diego, Kolar has also been resident conductor of the La Jolla Civic Orchestra and director of Mesa College Orchestra.
