### RALPH NADER - USD SPEAKER ON MARCH 15TH

San Diego, Calif., Ralph Nader, America's foremost critic, will speak at the University of San Diego at noon on March 15th. His lecture in USD's School of Law - Moore Hall auditorium is sponsored by the Graduate Student Association in conjunction with the Student Bar Association and the undergraduate's Associated Students Association. Nader's topic is Environmental Problems - Man Made - Man Remade. The crusading attorney was born in 1934 in Winsted, Conn. Graduating with honors from Princeton University in 1955, he received his law degree from Harvard in 1958. A dedicated, inexhaustably persistent crusader, Nader's entire life is devoted to the causes he champions. The public is invited to attend the 12:00 Noon lecture.

Dr. Gilbert Oddo, Chairman of USD's Graduate Division will host a luncheon honoring Ralph Nader at which time Dr. Auther E. Hughes USD President will greet him and student representatives of USD's three divisions - Undergraduate, Graduate and School of Law.
