USD MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP CONCERT - APRIL 23

San Diego, Calif., The second annual Special Music Scholarship Fund Concert will be held at the University of San Diego on Sunday, April 23 at 4 p.m. in Camino Theatre.

The concert will honor Sister Aimee Rossi, founder of this scholarship and Dean Emeritus of the University. Sister Rossi spends her days studying scholarship possibilities for students and working strenuously for the Music Department. Last year her successful efforts resulted in establishing a fund of \$1,500. Ken Jerahian, a violinist, was the first recipient of financial aid from this source. The concert expenses have already been funded therefore proceeds from the concert and the patrons will go directly into the Scholarship Fund.

The concert program will feature the Alcala Trio members each appearing as soloists. Conductor and violinist Dr. Henry Kolar will perform Beethoven's Romance in F Op. 50. Mrs. Marjorie Hart, violin cellist will play Elegy Op. 24 by Faure. Miss Ilana Mysior, pianist, will perform Liszt Hungarian Fantasy.

Donations for Patrons (\$10.00), Donors (\$25.00) and Benefactors (over \$25.000) will enable more and more students to study music in the fine USD Music Department. General admission will be \$2.50. Students with ID card, \$1.00. Tickets may be ordered by mail until April 19. Tickets will also be available at Fiddle 'n Bow Music Store, 839 Broadway in San Diego or at the Camino Theatre Box Office the afternoon of the performance.
