### BRIT HUME SPEAKS AT USD OCTOBER 23

A lecture sponsored by USD's Associated Student Body, the Graduate Students Association and the Student Bar Association at noon on October 23rd will be given by Brit Hume. The lecture will be in Camino Theatre on the campus of the University of San Diego and is open to the public.

Hume's topic will be Muckracking in the 70's. Hume is an investigative reporter for Jack Anderson's syndicated Washington Merry-Go-Round column. He is the reporter who talked with Dita Beard, the ITT lobbyist. The 28 year old journalist also was instrumental in the Anderson papers.

His recently published book, Death and the Mines, is an account of the United Mine Workers.

An English graduate from the University of Virginia, Hume worked for many national newspapers, including the Hartford Times and the Baltimore Evening Sun before joining Anderson.
