The Ad-Hoc Political Science Association of Southern California will hold a professional dinner meeting on Friday evening, November 9, 1973, at the University of San Diego. The subject "The Moral Individual in an Unjust Society: Law and Justice in Contemporary America" will be discussed.

The discussion will be initiated by four panel members each presenting briefly certain points on the theme. Panelists are: Richard Y. Funston, Ph.D., Prof. of Constitutional Law, San Diego State University; Michael V. Kuttnauer, Ph.D., Political Philosophy, San Diego Mesa College; Ronald L. Boostrom, Ph.D., Criminal Law, School of Public Administration and Urban Studies, San Diego State University; and John W. Swanke, Ph.D., Philosophy, University of San Diego. Association members will question panelists on the points of view they have advanced.

This is the tenth annual meeting of the Association and the fifth consecutive meeting at the University of San Diego. The program was arranged by Charles Andrain, Chairman of the Department of Political Science, San Diego State University; John S. Chambers, Assistant Professor of Political Science, University of San Diego; and Fred Horn, Assistant Professor of Political Science, San Diego Mesa College.
