Terri Ellen Rasmussen, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Robert A. Rasmussen of 1093 Sunset Cliffs, San Diego, was among sixteen candidates nominated for the title of 1973 Homecoming Queen at the University of San Diego.

Terri was selected to represent the Biology Club during the USD Homecoming festivities, October 30 - November 4. Candidates were nominated on the basis of personality, involvement in campus activities, and concern for the USD community.

A freshman majoring in biology, Terri plans to eventually study veterinary medicine.
