FULLERTON STUDENT CROWNED USD'S 1973 HOMECOMING QUEEN

Rosanne Stehly, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John W. Stehly of Fullerton, California was named 1973 Homecoming Queen at the University of San Diego.

Rosanne wore her crown during the October 30 - November 4 Homecoming festivities after winning a majority vote of the student body. She was among sixteen candidates nominated on the basis of personality, involvement in campus activities, and concern for the USD community.

A sophomore at USD, Rosanne represented the Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity in the election. In addition to her support of numerous campus concerns, she works part-time in the office of the Dean of Students.
