FINAL LECTURE IN USD GENETICS SERIES

NOVEMBER 13 - SOCIAL CONSEQUENCES

"Social Consequences" of the new genetics will be addressed from two viewpoints by the speaker Sister Emerine Glowienka, RSCJ, on November 13 at the University of San Diego. The lecture will begin at 7:30 p.m. in Salomon Lecture Hall, De Sales Hall, and is open to the public.

Holder of two Ph.D.'s, one in sociology from St. Louis University and the other in philosophy from Marquette, Sr. Glowienka will compare and contrast these two disciplines.

"Because I have two doctorates, I will discuss the impact of the new genetics on status-role relationships, on social processes, and on institutional structures as well as from the viewpoint of the social philosopher."

The speaker went on to say, "In this area I shall discuss its impact on the understanding of man as a social being, the concept of man as an evolving intelligence."

Sr. Glowienka is an assistant professor of philosophy at the University of San Diego. Her professional memberships include Phi Sigma Tau national honor society in philosophy, sponsorship of the lecture series, and AAUP. She is listed in Who's Who in the West.
