On March 7, Dr. Ronald H. Hill, Instructor in English, will speak on "The Duchess of Malfi" as part of a lecture series being offered by the Humanities Department of the University of San Diego. The 7:30 PM lecture will be in Salomon Lecture Hall, DeSales Hall, and is open to the public.

"The Duchess of Malfi", an Elizabethan play by J. Webster, was published in 1623. The plot deals with the social pressures brought to bear on the widowed Duchess who marries a commoner and finally dies tragically as a result of her love.

Dr. Hill received his M.A. and Ph.D. from UC Santa Barbara. The subject of his dissertation was "The Duchess of Malfi and the Feminine Tradition, An Investigation of the Development of the Full Female Character in Renaissance Tragic Drama".

On March 14, Mr. Irving Parker will speak on "Milton" at 7:30 PM in Founders Hall.

The series will conclude on March 28 when the Dean of the USD College of Arts & Sciences, Dr. Edward E. Foster, talks on John Dryden at 7:30 PM in Salomon Lecture Hall.

All of the lectures are open to the public.
