PALM SPRINGS STUDENT HONORED AT USD CONVOCATION

Pamela Alice Summers, of Palm Springs, California was named as receiving the James S. Kemper Foundation tuition scholarship for business administration students at the sixth annual University of San Diego Honors Convocation May 18. The scholarship was applied to her tuition in the fall semester, 1973. Miss Summers is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Sidney E. Summers.

A freshman majoring in business administration, Pamela was among three students to receive the scholarship based on demonstrated superior character, good citizenship, ability and ambition. Miss Summers is a 1973 graduate of Palm Springs High School.

The University of San Diego is comprised of one college and three professional schools: the College of Arts and Sciences, School of Business Administration, School of Education and School of Law.
