"Ensemble problems in performing chamber music literature for violin and keyboard" will be the subject of a lecture-demonstration by Dr. Henry Kolar March 9 at the University of San Diego. The program is set for 10 a.m. in the French Parlor of Founders Hall.

Kolar, Associate Professor of Music at USD, conducts the USD Orchestra and is currently Concertmaster of the La Jolla Chamber Orchestra.
