ECONOMIC LAWS AND POLITICAL LEGISLATION TOPIC AT USD

"Economic Laws and Political Legislation" will be discussed April 1 by Dr. Armen Alchian at the University of San Diego. Alchian, Professor of Economics at the University of California, Los Angeles, will speak at 8 pm in Salomon Lecture Hall. There is no charge.

Alchian has taught at UCLA since 1946, and was a Research Economist for the RAND Corporation from 1946-1964. He has also been a consultant to the Institute for Defense Analysis, the Center for Naval Analysis, and the National Association of Manufacturers, Education Council. He earned his B.A. and Ph.D. from Stanford University. He is the author of numerous articles in economic and educational journals, and is co-author of University Economics (1971) and Exchange and Production (1969).

Alchian's speech is part of the Distinguished Lecture Series in Law and Economics presented by the University of San Diego School of Law and open to the public. The Series has two more guest speakers: Dean Harry Wellington of Yale Law School who will speak on April 8 on "Collective Bargaining in the Public Sector" and Dr. Bernard Siegan, Distinguished Professor of Law, USD, scheduled to conclude the Series with a lecture on April 22 on "Regulating the Use of Land."
