LAWYER'S ASSISTANT PROGRAM

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Students from 25 states and 85 undergraduate colleges have completed the University of San Diego Lawyer's Assistant Program in its first two sessions. Approximately 3,700 inquiries have been received for the 12-week program which was initiated in June of 1975.

85% of the students who successfully completed the Summer Session of 1975 are employed throughout the United States.

The program employs two part-time assistants who work with Director Martha Metzger in placement. They are Gayle Graham, a Stanford graduate, and Barbara Miller, a graduate of William and Mary. Both are members of the San Diego Bar Auxiliary.
