CALIFORNIA SUPREME COURT JUSTICE TO SPEAK AT USD.

California Supreme Court Justice Stanley Mosk will speak on "The New States' Rights," Thursday, April 14, 3 p.m. in Salomon Lecture Hall, University of San Diego. The lecture is sponsored by the USD Law School Speakers Bureau at no charge to the public.

Mosk, who received an honorary doctor of law degree from USD in 1971, has served on the Supreme Court since 1964. He is the author of many important court opinions, including the recent Bakke v. Board of Regents case which declared minority admission standards unconstitutional. A graduate of University of Chicago, he is the former California attorney general and legal advisor to the governor of California in 1942.
