ANNUAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION AT USD

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

The annual Roger J. Traynor California Moot Court Competition will be hosted by the Moot Court Board of the University of San Diego School of Law on April 7 and 8. The preliminary rounds on April 7 will be held in San Diego County Superior Court and judged by local bar and bench. The final rounds will be held in the Joseph P. Grace Courtroom in the USD School of Law building on April 8.

Judges for the final rounds are Chief Justice Cameron Batjer of the Supreme Court of Nevada, Justice George A. Hopper of the 5th District Court of Appeal, and Justice Otto M. Kaus of the 2nd District Court of Appeal.

Eighteen teams will compete in a criminal appeal based on the legality of a search and seizure and the constitutionality of California Penal Code §11550. The California Young Lawyers Association of the California State Bar Association prepares the moot court problem and develops the rules and guidelines.
