AAUP NATIONAL PRESIDENT TO SPEAK AT USD, OCTOBER 16

Martha Friedman, national president of the American Association of University Professors, will speak to faculty members of the University of San Diego, UCSD, and other area private colleges at USD's Serra Hall Faculty Lounge on Tuesday, October 16, from 4 to 5:30 p.m.

The presentation and reception for Ms. Friedman rounds out a day-long visit to San Diego by the AAUP official. At 11 a.m., she will speak to AAUP members and interested faculty at San Diego State University, and at 2 p.m., Friedman will address area college librarians at SDSU.

The theme of Friedman's presentations will be "Collegiality and Changing Times," which will deal with the issues facing faculty members in times of tightening budgets.

Friedman has been national AAUP president since 1978, when she was elected for a two-year term. She is a History and Philosophy Librarian at the University of Illinois, and has served in various AAUP capacities since 1965. Friedman has a B.A. and M.A. from the University of Missouri, and an M.A. from the University of Illinois.
