AFFIRMATIVE ACTION AND COLLECTIVE BARGAINING TOPIC OF USD PROGRAM, MARCH 14

"Affirmative Action and Collective Bargaining: Making It Work For You" is the topic of an all-day program co-sponsored by the University of San Diego Labor-Management Relations Center and the National Conference of Christians and Jews, to be held on Friday, March 14, at the San Diego Hilton Hotel, starting at 9 a.m.

The program will report on significant developments in the field of Equal Employment Opportunity, and is recommended for personnel directors, labor union leaders, contract negotiators, managers, employment interviewers and counselors, attorneys and paralegals.

Workshops will examine case studies of various compliance objectives. Participants include: Josiah Neeper, attorney; John Edgington, San Diego Newspaper Guild; Clarence Pendleton, San Diego Urban League; Lavan Carmen, San Diego Office of E.E.O.C.; Robert Bell, management attorney; and Doug Olins, labor attorney.
