AWARD-WINNING ARTWORKS TO BE DISPLAYED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SAN DIEGO

The Eighth Annual Student All-Media Competitive Exhibition will open at the University of San Diego Founder's Gallery on Sunday, April 27. The festivities, beginning at 6 p.m., include a reception, awards dinner and Mass for the juror, artists, their families, friends, and patrons.

All works on display have been created this academic year by USD art students. The creations, in ceramic, photography, sculpture, drawing, weaving, painting, and print-making, will be selected by Martin Peterson, Curator of American and European Art at the San Diego Museum of Art. The competition will be held Saturday, April 26, in Founder's Gallery. Winning works will be awarded First, Second and Third Prizes. Two Purchase Prizes will also be awarded, wherein the artists accept prize money in exchange for the artwork. The University retains the purchased artwork to display on campus.

The exhibition, designed and installed by USD Exhibition Design students, will be open to the public from 10-4 weekdays through May 23. Admission is free.
