SANTA ANA RESIDENT NAMED OUTSTANDING USD WOMAN STUDENT

Carrie Galvin, a graduate from Mater Dei High School in Santa Ana, has been given the Alcala Award as the outstanding University of San Diego senior woman. The award was given during USD's 1980 Commencement Exercises, held last Sunday, May 25.

Galvin, who graduated Cum Laude, was honored for her academic achievements and service to the University and to the community. She also delivered the Senior Address.

During the past academic year, Galvin served as President of the Accounting Society and as Director of the USD Freshman Orientation.

She received a B.B.A. in Accounting.

Joining Galvin were 573 other USD students who received Bachelor's and Master's Degrees, and 302 law students who received Juris Doctor Degrees.

Addressing the students were Rev. Theodore Hesburgh, President of the University of Notre Dame, and A. Leon Higginbotham, Jr., U.S. Circuit Court Judge for the Third Circuit.
