ANTITRUST CONFERENCE HOSTED BY USD JUNE 12-14

The Lyle L. Jones Conference, "Proving and Disproving Damages in a Sherman Act case", will be held June 12-14, at the Vacation Village Hotel in San Diego.

The three day program, sponsored by the University of San Diego Office of Continuing Education, will be highlighted by demonstrations in a courtroom format of damage witness examinations by outstanding antitrust trial lawyers.

Deputy Asst. Attorney General, Richard J. Favretto, heads the list of featured speakers which includes, David Berger of Berger & Montague, P.C., in Pennsylvania; Professor Martin Lewis, University of South Dakota School of Law; Christopher Q. Britton of Sullivan, Jones & Archer, San Diego; and Julian O. van Kalinowski of Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher, Los Angeles.

United States District Judges, William Enright and William A. Ingram, will preside over the trial demonstrations of plaintiffs Stephan D. Susman of Mandel & Wright, Houston, and Michael N. Khourie of Khourie & Schultz, San Francisco, and defendants Fred A. Bartlett, Jr. of Kirkland & Ellis, Chicago, and Max Hendrik III of Vinson & Ellis, Houston. Willard F. Mueller will act as expert witness.
