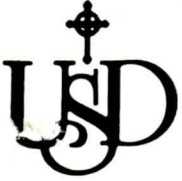

Four new faculty members have been appointed for the 1980-81 school year at the University of San Diego's School of Education, Dean Edward DeRoche has announced.

Dr. Sally A. Kochendofer has a Ph.D. from Indiana State University in Counseling and Psychological Services. She earned her B.S. and M.S. from the State University of New York at Plattsburg. Before coming to USD, she served as Assistant Professor of Human Development and Learning at the University of North Carolina.

Dr. Sylvia Lane Lewis arrives at USD to head a federal grant program which will improve the training of educators who deal with handicapped students. She received her B.S. in Special Education from State University of New York at Buffalo, and her M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Michigan. Her areas of graduate emphasis were in trainable mentally retarded, emotionally disturbed, and learning disabled students. She previously taught at Southwest Texas State University at San Marcos, Texas; and at the University of Nevada at Las Vegas.

Arriving from the School of Education at Southern Illinois University, Edwardsville, Illinois, is Dr. Rosalie Going Rhoads. She received her Ph.D. in Special Education from St. Louis University, St. Louis, Missouri. She received her undergraduate degree from Southern Illinois, and has also studied at the Ferris Robbins Institute in Switzerland.
