#### ADMINISTRATIVE LAW COLLEGE AT USD JUNE 24-27

The Administrative Law College of the California State Bar will present a program for government-employed advocates and adjudicators at the University of San Diego, June 24 through June 27.

Registration for the session is \$290, which includes tuition, lodging, meals, and materials. Pre-registration is requested. For details, call USD's Office of Continuing Education at 293-4585.

Although the session is primarily for governmental employees (including administrative law judges, hearing officers, and members of boards and commissions), privately-employed advocates and adjudicators may enroll if space is available.

A workshop format with small groups led by experienced instructors will be used in the College sessions. Students will be assigned either to Advocate training or Adjudicator training, depending on background and interest. Topics covered will include: hearsay in administrative hearings, evidence, prehearing and hearing procedure, making an administrative record, administrative and appellate review, and legal writing.
