SUMMER SCHOOL AT U.S.D.

The University of San Diego's Summer School session, beginning June 22 and lasting through August 24, will offer courses to be taken for credit or for personal enrichment. Additional sessions begin July 13 and August 3.

Tuition fees are \$135 per unit of credit for undergraduates. A half-price rate for clergy of all faiths and auditors is available. Graduate-level tuition fees are \$140 and \$155 per unit. Room and board are available on campus. Pre-enrollment is requested; for details, call USD's Office of Continuing Education at 293-4585.

The College of Arts and Sciences will offer 34 courses, including Art Fundamentals, History of Jazz, Christian Marriage, Computer Fundamentals, and Intermediate Spanish.

The School of Education offers 27 courses, including off-campus fieldwork, as well as on-campus studies. Topics include: Principalship, Group Counseling, Learning Disabilities, Research Methodology, and School Finance.

The Philip Y. Hahn School of Nursing offers two courses: Perinatal Nursing: Theory and Application; and The Nurse and the Law.
